

- 4. Nothing in this Order is, or shall be deemed to be, a change to or variation of the jurisdiction of the director under the *Environmental Management Act*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 53, in relation to Site ID: 26217.
- 5. The appeal is dismissed, without costs.
